

Poster Presentation EUCAS 2015 Guidelines

All poster sessions will take place in the Exhibit Hall (forum 2 and 3) of the Lyon Convention Center.

If you present a poster session, please take note of the following:

- Each **vertical** poster board measures 1.2 m (height, top to bottom) x 0.9 m (width, right to left), it fits A0 format (0.841 x 1,189 m²)
- Each poster board has two sides (front and back), but each poster is assigned to one single side of the board
- Poster boards will be numbered as follows (for Monday) including color code:
 - **1A-E-P-01, 1A-E-P-02...** for Electronics (green),
 - **1A-LS-P-01, 1A-LS-P-02...** for Large Scale (red)
 - **1A-M-P-01, 1A-M-P-02...** for Material (blue)
 - **1A-W&T-P-01, 1A-W&T-P-02...** for Wire and Tapes (purple).
- The zones for the categories will be clearly indicated.
- Invited poster (modelling special session) presenters will have two poster board sides available.
- Please display the presentation ID prominently in the title area of the poster.
- Poster presenters are expected to arrange their material on poster boards before the session starts (see table below). Presenters may bring pre-prints or handouts and make them available on the poster board, see "setup".
- Only papers that are presented at EUCAS 2015 may be considered for publication. For posters, the word "presented" means that **an author must be present during the entire session and available for discussion**. Attendance will be taken by the session chairs; if an author cannot be located, the paper written from this poster will **not** be considered for publication in the special conference issue of the IEEE TRANSACTIONS ON APPLIED SUPERCONDUCTIVITY.
- Authors will be permitted to view other posters in the nearby area where posters of similar topic are clustered. Please keep in mind that authors are expected to be available for attendees.
- If you have more than one poster and they are not side by side, then you need to spread your time over all poster presentations. Please note on the poster board your other location(s) and the time you expect to be present. Please also inform the session chair(s).
- It is **NOT acceptable** to merely post a copy of your paper. Such papers will be marked as a "no-show" presentation.

Please note that EUCAS 2015 accepts no responsibility for material that may be left behind, lost, stolen, or damaged.

If you need to **make changes or withdraw your abstract** from the program **BEFORE** the Conference, please contact S. Riondet via eucas2015@neel.cnrs.fr . If you need to **make changes or withdraw your presentation** from the program **ON-SITE** at the Conference, please advise the staff in the **Publications Office (salon Lumière)**. Please be sure to provide your presentation ID number (e.g. 1A-E-P-01, 2A-LS-P-03, 3A-M-P-05, etc.) on any correspondence.
